



International College Announcement on  
Application for Graduate Scholarships "New Generation of Social Entrepreneur  
Graduates" for the Academic Year 2024

The International College has a policy to provide financial support for Thai and international students in graduate studies to demonstrate the strength of the International College's graduate education and also to develop cooperation in both teaching and research with other countries, especially those in Asia. This provision is considered an essential measure in line with the International College's operational plan at Maejo University in the fiscal years 2025-2026 to develop the International College into a leading educational institution in Asia. Scholarships will be allocated for "New Generation of Social Entrepreneur Graduates," as shown in the following scholarship application details.

1. Qualifications of those eligible to apply for scholarships
  - 1.1 They must be Thai or international students in the Digital Economics and Management Innovation Program affiliated with the International College at Maejo University.
  - 1.2 They must be students studying in the second year.
  - 1.3 They must have a cumulative grade point average of over 3.25.
2. Amount of allocated fund
  - Doctoral degree level, one scholarship, amount 70,000 baht
  - Master's degree level, six scholarships, 5,000 baht each, totalling 30,000 baht.
3. Evidence for application
  - (1) Application for scholarship according to the International College form.
  - (2) Academic report for every semester.
4. Fund allocation

The fund will be allocated to students with all the qualifications according to item 1.
5. Consideration

The Graduate Scholarship Allocation Committee of the International College for the academic year 2024 is responsible for selecting scholarship recipients and allocating funds.

6. Conditions for receiving scholarships

- 6.1 Scholarship recipients must submit a study report and progress report on the dissertation/thesis or independent research report to the Office of the Dean of the International College at the end of each semester with the approval of the advisor as follows:
  - (a) First semester: Submit it by the third week of November
  - (b) Second semester: Submit it by the first week of April.
- 6.2 Their academic work must be submitted to the Office of the Dean of the International College upon graduation as a PDF file as follows:
  - (a) Abstract, approval page, and acknowledgements of the dissertation, thesis, or independent research report.
  - (b) An article published in a full paper in an academic journal at the national or international levels as listed in TCI, ISI, Scopus, or Scimago databases.
  - (c) The scholarship receipts must also state the acknowledgement of their dissertation, thesis, or independent study report and published articles.
- 6.3 They are supposed to help with public relations, work coordination, and organizing the program's course activities.
- 6.4 Granting of scholarships is a one-time activity.
- 6.5 The decision of the Scholarship Allocation Committee is final.

7. Applying for scholarships

1. Download the application form at [www.https://mju-ic.mju.ac.th](http://www.https://mju-ic.mju.ac.th) (main menu, document box, scholarship topic) from now until March 20, 2024.
2. Submit the proposed application form to be signed by the advisor with evidence of application according to item 3 to the International Colleges by March 20, 2024.
3. Announcement of the names of those eligible for the interview on March 31, 2024.
